


HIDING GOD'S WORD IN MY HEART


MEMORY VERSE PRACTICE - INVESTIGATE GOD'S WORD











TRAIL MAZE

God wants us to seek out wisdom - from the Bible, through prayer, and by asking people that we trust who love God. But it's not enough for us to just ask for wisdom; we need to use the advice we get.

In the box below draw a picture of someone in your life you think is wise. Spend time in prayer and thank God for giving you this person. Ask Him to help you use the advice you get from them.












MEMORY VERSE PRACTICE - KNOW IT BY HEART

Read Proverbs 1:5

We can use textbooks or even the Internet for finding answers to questions like, "Who was the 3rd President?" or "How do I do this math problem?"

Sometimes though we have questions that are harder to answer. We ask things like, "Should I forgive my friend for saying mean things about me?" or "Does God get sad when I do bad things?" There is one book that has the answers to questions like this and you can trust everything in it is true because it's from God! That book is the Bible.

No matter how old we get we will always have questions that seem hard to find the answers to; but God promises us that if we look to Him and His Word He will show us what to do.

Do you have questions you don't know the answers to? If so, ask your parents, small group leader, or another adult that you trust who believes in Jesus, to help you look in the Bible for the answers.

Spend time praying for God to help you grow in wisdom by showing you the answers to your questions in the Bible.









THE ULTIMATE SOURCE OF WISDOM

Read Colossians 2:2-3

This verse is a great reminder that Jesus is the only one with all of the answers. When we try to make decisions on our own without spending time praying and asking God for wisdom, or looking in the Bible for answers, we will get it wrong.

This verse also reminds us that only in Jesus are we able to gain wisdom. When we know Jesus and we believe in Him, He will help guide us to make wise decisions in our life.

Spend some time today praying and asking God to help you make wise choices. Thank Him for sending us Jesus so that we can have a relationship with Him.
