

Today's story from the Bible begins with a guy named Joshua. Joshua was the leader of God's army. Let's stand up and march, like we're pretending to be in Joshua's army! (Lead your toddler in marching in place.)

God told Joshua he would take over the city of Jericho. But the city of Jericho had a HUGE wall that went all the way around it. The wall was BIG and STRONG, which made the city of Jericho very hard to get into.





Joshua wasn't sure how it was all going to happen, but he knew he could trust God's plan.

God's plan was for Joshua's army to take horns and blow them while marching around the wall, one time a day, for six days. Let's count to six!

(Lead your toddler in counting to six.)

Joshua didn't understand how God's plan would work, but he trusted God and did what God told him to do.

Joshua's army got their horns and marched around the wall each day. Then, on day seven, God told Joshua to march around the wall seven times and give a loud shout!

So, they marched around the city one, two, three, four, five, six, seven times. They shouted and the wall fell down!

Sometimes we may not understand how God's plan will work, but we can always trust God, just like Joshua did! Who can trust God? (Encourage your toddler to say, "I can trust God.")
