KEY QUESTION

- PART 1 -

VIDEO: "Quest Rules Video"

SLIDE: "WCLU Campus Screen Graphic"

STORYTELLER: "Hello friends! Welcome to Quest and welcome to the Wonder! Clubhouse! This month we're learning that we don't have to worry or be afraid because God's got it!"

STORYTELLER: "I know that no matter where I go or what I do, God's got it under control! When I say, 'Who's got it?' you say, 'God's got it!' Let's practice! 'Who's got it?'"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God's got it!"

STORYTELLER: "Great job! God's got a plan for us whether we're at a neighborhood camp out or we're playing on a soccer or baseball team, and that's something to celebrate! Let's sing songs today thanking God for always having a perfect plan. Let's stand to our feet and sing, 'Trustin' N U!'" **SONG: "Trustin' N U"**

Lead children in singing, "Trustin' N U," with the hand motions.

SONG: "Get Up"

Lead children in singing, "Get Up," with the hand motions.

- PART 2 -

STORYTELLER: "Thanks for worshipping with me, friends. Before you have a seat, tell me, **'Who's got it?'**"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God's got it!"

STORYTELLER: "That's right! God's got it! We don't need to worry, be afraid, or feel alone because our Bible verse for this month tells us God will be with us no matter what. Listen to the Bible verse as I say it, then, you can say it after me. Listen carefully:

'God (point both hands straight up) is with you (point out to a friend) wherever (wave hands in a circle) you go.' (march in place) Joshua 1:9" (open hands like a book)

STORYTELLER, THEN CHILDREN: "God (point both hands straight up) is with you (point out to a friend) wherever (wave hands in a circle) you go.' (march in place) Joshua 1:9" (open hands like a book)

Repeat the memory verse two more times and have kids repeat it with you.

STORYTELLER: "Great job, friends! Let's say it one more time, 'Who's got it?'"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God's got it!"

STORYTELLER: "Yes! That's the truth, friends! Today, we get to hear the story about a tiny little baby who was a big part of God's plan. Let's check in with Ollie at the Wonder! Clubhouse to learn more."

- PART 3 -

STORYTELLER: "God's plan was to keep Moses safe and help him grow up to be the leader of God's people. God had a plan all along!"

STORYTELLER: "Remind me again, 'Who's got it?"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God's got it!"

STORYTELLER: "Yes! That's the truth, friends. God had a plan for baby Moses, just like He has a plan for each one of us. Let's bow our heads, close our eyes, and thank God for His perfect plan."

STORYTELLER: "Dear God, I pray that You will help us remember that Your plan is perfect. No matter where we are or what's happening, we can trust that You've got it. You're the best, God, and we love You very much. In Jesus' name, amen.

STORYTELLER: "Now friends, it's time for us to head back to our eGroups where you're going to learn more God's plan for our lives."

STORYTELLER: "Where is the _____ (color of Quest Animal eGroup, ie: Purple Parrot) eGroup? You can go ahead and line up with your eGroup Leader at the door and go back to eGroup."
