Angels tell the Shepherds the Good News coloring page - Have your child put the Angels tell the Shepherds the Good News coloring page on a branch of your Christmas tree. Each time you and your child are by the tree, celebrate how glad you are that God sent baby Jesus to be born. You can celebrate by having a celebration dance! Give your child streamers and play your family's favorite Christmas music. Encourage your child to dance around and wave the streamers to celebrate that baby Jesus is born!

Nativity sticker page - Use the Nativity sticker page your child created and recreate an edible version of the scene by making a *Baby in a Manger snack* with your child. Help your child place shredded carrots into the pocket of the pita bread for hay. Next, help him/her place a banana "baby" in the pocket on top of the carrots. Talk with your child about how glad you are that God sent baby Jesus.
