STORYTELLER: "Hello friends and welcome to the Wonder! Clubhouse! This month we've been learning that God helps us do big things. In fact, I want everyone to turn to your neighbor, give them a BIG two thumbs up, and tell them, 'God helps me do big things!'"

Have kids give their neighbor a big two thumbs up and tell them, "God helps me do big things!"

STORYTELLER: "That's right friends! This month we've been learning about a few ways God helped people in the Bible do some pretty big things. God wants to help you do big things, too! When I say, '**Who helps you do big things?**' you say, '**God helps me do big things!**' Let's practice! '**Who helps you do big things?**'"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God helps me do big things!"

STORYTELLER: "Yes, He does! God can help you do big things, and that's something we can all celebrate together! Everyone stand up, dance, and help me sing a song called, 'Hip Hip Hooray.'"

SONG: "Hip Hip Hooray"

Lead children in singing, "Hip Hip Hooray," with the hand motions.

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- PART 2 -

STORYTELLER: "Thanks for worshipping with me, friends! Before you have a seat, tell me, 'Who helps you do big things?'"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God helps me do big things!"

STORYTELLER: "That's right! The Bible tells us that God loves us and is always there to help us, which is what our memory verse is all about. Listen to the memory verse as I say it, then, you'll repeat it with me with the hand motions. Today we're going to do something a little different. We're going to say the memory verse three times, and each time we say it we're going to say it faster and faster. I'll say it one time by myself, then we'll all say it together faster and faster. Listen carefully:

'We have (*cross arms in front of you*) the Lord our God (*one hand on hip, the other pointing up*) to help us.' (*both hands on hips*) 2 Chronicles 32:8" (*open hands like a book*)

STORYTELLER, THEN CHILDREN QUICKLY: "We have (*cross arms in front of you*) the Lord our God (*one hand on hip, the other pointing up*) to help us.' (*both hands on hips*) 2 Chronicles 32:8" (*open hands like a book*)

Repeat the memory verse three times and have kids repeat it after you, getting faster each time.

STORYTELLER: "Great job, friends! Tell me, 'Who helps you do big things?'"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God helps me do big things!"

STORYTELLER: "Yes! That's the truth, friends! Today we're going to learn about the time God helped David fight a BIG, mean giant. Let's check in with Ollie at the Wonder! Clubhouse to learn more."

STORYTELLER: "David wasn't afraid to face the giant because he knew that God was with him and would help him. Tell me, **'Who helps you do big things?'**"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: **"God helps me do big things!"**

STORYTELLER: "That's right! Just like God helped David, He will help us do brave things, too! Now let's close our eyes and pray together."

STORYTELLER: "Dear God, thank You for the amazing TRUE story of David and Goliath. We can be brave like David because You are with us. Thank You for helping us do big things even if we're afraid. We love You, God! Amen."

STORYTELLER: "Now friends, it's time for us to head back to our eGroups where you're going to learn more about how God can help you do brave things."

STORYTELLER: "Where is the _____ (color of Quest Animal eGroup, ie: Teal Tiger) eGroup? You can go ahead and line up with your eGroup Leader at the door and go back to eGroup."
