## - PART 1 -

**VIDEO: "Quest Rules Video"**

**SLIDE: "WCLU Campus Screen Graphic"**

**STORYTELLER:** "Hello friends and welcome to the Wonder! Clubhouse! This month we're learning that God made you and you and you and you! In fact, I want you to point to three friends and say, 'God made **YOU!**' Find three friends now!"

**STORYTELLER:** "That's right friends! This month we're learning that God made YOU and you are wonderfully made. When I say, '**Who made you?**' you say, '**God made me!**' Let's practice! '**Who made you?**'"

**CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God made me!"**

**STORYTELLER:** "Yes, He did! God made you and you are SO important to God, and God loves you more than anything! You know what? That's something we should all celebrate together. Everyone stand up, dance, and help me sing a song called, '*More Than Anything.*'"

**SONG: "More Than Anything"**

*Lead children in singing, "More Than Anything," with the hand motions.*

**SONG: "Cool"**

*Lead children in singing, "Cool," with the hand motions.*

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## - PART 2 -

**STORYTELLER:** "Thanks for worshipping with me, friends. Before you have a seat, tell me, 'Who made you?'"

**CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER:** "God made me!"

**STORYTELLER:** "That's right! The Bible tells us that we're all wonderfully made and that God made us in His own image. Listen to the memory verse as I say it, then, you'll repeat it with me with the hand motions. But today we're going to do something a little different. We're going to say the memory verse three times, and each time we say it we're going to say it faster and faster. I'll say it one time by myself, then we'll all say it together faster and faster. Listen carefully:

*'I am (point arms to chest) fearfully (right arm muscle) and wonderfully (left arm muscle) made.' (clap hands together) Psalm 139:14" (open your hands like a book)*

**STORYTELLER, THEN CHILDREN QUICKLY:** "I am (point arms to chest) fearfully (right arm muscle) and wonderfully (left arm muscle) made.' (clap hands together) Psalm 139:14" (open your hands like a book)

*Repeat the memory verse three times and have kids repeat it after you, getting faster each time.*

**STORYTELLER:** "Great job, friends! Let's say it one more time, 'Who made you?'"

**CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER:** "God made me!"

**STORYTELLER:** "Yes! That's the truth, friends! Today we're going to learn something very important: how to respect ourselves. But how do we do that? Let's check in with Ollie at the Wonder! Clubhouse to find out."

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## - PART 3 -

**STORYTELLER:** "God wants us to take care of the bodies He made. God wants us to get sleep, brush our teeth, go to the doctor, eat healthy foods, and play outside. Remember God made you, and you are important to Him, so take care of the body God gave you!"

**STORYTELLER:** "Remind me again: 'Who made you?'"

**CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER:** "God made me!"

**STORYTELLER:** "Yes! God made you! Let's pray."

**STORYTELLER:** "Heavenly Father, thank You for the amazing bodies YOU have given us. Help us to make the right choices when it comes to how we treat and respect our bodies. They are a gift from You. Thanks for the wonderful way You have made each one of us. We love You, God. Amen."

**STORYTELLER:** "Now friends, it's time for us to head back to our eGroups where you're going to learn more about how God made us to respect ourselves."

**STORYTELLER:** "Where is the \_\_\_\_\_ (color of Quest Animal eGroup, ie: Purple Parrot) eGroup? You can go ahead and line up with your eGroup Leader at the door and go back to eGroup."
