

**Drawn Out (about 5 minutes)**

Supplies: pens, sticky notes, ½ sheet of poster board

Give each family member 2 - 4 sticky notes and ask them to draw a picture on each sticky note in 2 minutes or less. Once they have completed each picture ask them to come up and stick it on the piece of poster board. Pictures should be put on the board in the order that they are completed.

Once your entire family has placed their pictures on the board ask for one family member to come up and tell a story about obedience using the pictures that your family drew. They can make up a story about someone who chose to obey, or someone who chose to disobey. The only requirement is that it should relate to the pictures your family drew. Once one family member has finished, allow others to come up and make up other stories using the pictures drawn.

**Say,** "Making up those stories was easy for some of us, but for others it was hard. Obeying isn't always easy and we won't always make the best choice. When we do mess up we need to ask forgiveness from those we disobeyed, and work hard to obey in the future."
