Humility - Putting Others Before Yourself

Bible Verse - "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves." Philippians 2:3 NIV

Supplies: colored chalk, black butcher paper (if completing the activity inside)

Head outside to a sidewalk or driveway and have each family member draw a picture that represents humility. The picture can be anything that shows humility - it can show an example of someone being humble, words that represent humility, or something else that comes to mind.

Allow 4-5 minutes for each family member to draw their picture and then have your family walk around looking at the examples of humility that each family member drew. Have your family stand or sit around the pictures as you pray.

"Dear God, thank you for giving us Jesus as an example of humility. We thank you that He showed us how to be humble and how to put others first. Help us to not think of ourselves as better than others, but help us to remember that we are all your children and you created each of us with great gifts that we can use for you. Help us to put others first this week. Amen."
