

HOW DID JESUS SAVE THE WORLD? | ROMANS 6:23

As a family, watch this week's video and then discuss a few questions together.

QUESTION 1:

Why do we celebrate Easter? What did Jesus do for us?

QUESTION 2:

What were some ways Jesus surprised people who were waiting for a savior?

QUESTION 3:

How does it make you feel to know that, no matter what you do, God loves you?

FAMILY ACTIVITY: VERSE CHALLENGE

WHAT YOU NEED:

Pens/markers, 17 slips of paper per team, 17 Easter eggs per team, one paper bag or basket per team (This activity can be done without Easter eggs — if you don't have enough eggs for each team, have teams put their paper in the bag/basket instead.)

WHAT YOU DO:

Divide your family into teams with at least two people on each team.

Give each team 17 slips of paper and something to write with.

Have them write the following words on each slip of paper, place each slip of paper in an egg, then place their eggs in a bag or basket:

For the	of God	Loudly say, "I love eKidz!"
wages of	Sing "Happy Birthday" to someone	is eternal life
do 10 push-ups	sin is death.	in Christ Jesus
Stand on one foot and count to 30	but the	our Lord
do 10 jumping jacks	Turn around 5 times	gift
Bark like a dog 10 times	Romans 6:23 (NIV)	

WHAT YOU SAY:

- "Let's see which team can be the fastest at putting together today's Bible verse, Romans 6:23."
- "Each team has a bag of eggs. Inside each egg is either words from our verse or a challenge to complete!"
- "Your team has to draw out eggs one at a time. If it's a word from the verse, put it down in order. If it's a challenge, your **whole team** has to do the challenge. Then you can draw your next egg. The first team with their whole verse laid out in order wins! Ready? Go!"
