Learn it:

Read Luke 4: 1-13 – Think about the last time you were really hungry and thirsty and it seemed to take forever for you to get something to eat or drink. That happened to Jesus too; and to make it worse, Satan showed up to tempt and tease Him. Jesus didn't fall for Satan's tricks, but fought back with scripture. It's important to know what the Bible says so you can fight temptation.

Do it:

Learn it:

Read Proverbs 2: 1-6 & 9-11 – What kind of food and snacks do you have in your house? The Bible says that Jesus stored up God's Word in His heart. He had what He needed so He could use His knowledge exactly when He needed it.

Do it:

Think of 3 things you struggle with (like remembering to clean your room, or being kind to your siblings) and ask your parents to help you find some verses in the Bible that will help you when you struggle with those things.

Pray:

Ask God to help you store up His Word and bring it to your mind when you need it most.



Learn it:

Read Proverbs 1:7 – It's not really how much you know but who you know that matters. Getting to know God is the most important thing of all.
