## DAY 3: GOD KNOWS ME

Read Genesis 24:2-4

In Bible days parents typically found the husband or wife for their kids to marry. They were called arranged marriages and in some countries today this still happens. Can you imagine your dad picking out the person you are supposed to be married to?

It may seem crazy to you but as a parent Abraham wanted the best possible wife for his son Isaac. He was even willing to send one of his servants a long way away to find her and that probably made Isaac feel pretty good about who his dad would choose for him. Our parents want the best for us too. That's why they give us rules to follow and discipline us when we do things we aren't supposed to do.

God wants the very best for us too. He is willing to do whatever it takes to help us become the best version of us that we can be. Are you acting like a child of God and making room for God to give you His best by showing integrity in all situations?

Think of 3 things your parents do because they want what is best for you. Write them a thank you letter for helping you become the best you that you can be. Give them the note or put it somewhere they will find it.

Pray and thank God for wanting the best for us as His children. Ask Him to help you have integrity by doing what is right.

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## DAY 4: WHAT'S IN A NAME

Read Micah 6:8

Have you ever said, "That's not fair?" and felt like you were the only one being punished for something that wasn't entirely your fault? Did you demand that justice be served? When this verse says that we should act justly it is saying that we should act fairly and with integrity. We should do what is right because we are children of God.

The second thing this verse tells us to do is love mercy. Mercy means not getting what we deserve. We all mess up and get things wrong and we don't deserve for God to love us the way He does – but He does anyway. Not only does He love us, but He wants the best for us. He wants us to keep trying, to trust Him, and do what He tells us to do.

As you go throughout your day look for examples of people in your life who are acting justly, or with integrity, and compliment them for choosing to do the right thing. When you mess up pray and thank God for His mercy then ask him to help you choose to act with integrity the next time.

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## DAY 1: WEEKEND IN REVIEW

This weekend we learned from the Bink kids that we can't hide from God and that no matter what He still loves us. Muddle and Dom's dad knew what was best for them when he went out of town and even though they didn't obey him he still loved them and forgave them.

In our Bible story we read that Jonah chose not to listen to God and God sent a big fish to swallow him up. God knew what was best for Jonah and had a special plan for Him. He used the fish to remind Jonah how important it was to obey Him.
