Read 1 Timothy 1:15-16. The books of 1 Timothy and 2 Timothy are letters that the apostle (teacher and Bible leader) Paul wrote to Timothy to help encourage him as he was growing in his faith and learning to teach others about Jesus. When Paul says that Jesus came to save sinners - of whom he was the worst - he meant it.

Before Paul became a follower of Christ he spent his days threatening and killing Christians. He preached against what Jesus was saying!

In 1 Timothy 1:15-16, Paul is trying to tell Timothy that no matter how much he messes up or what he does, God will still love him and has a plan to use him. Paul went on to be one of the most influential men and wrote many of the books in the Bible. God wants to use us too.

It's OK that we mess up sometimes as long as we admit that what we did was wrong and work hard not to do it again.

Find a piece of paper and write your own letter to God confessing the things that you have done wrong and asking Him to help you do what is right in the future. Make sure you take time in your letter to thank God for his forgiveness and for loving you no matter what!

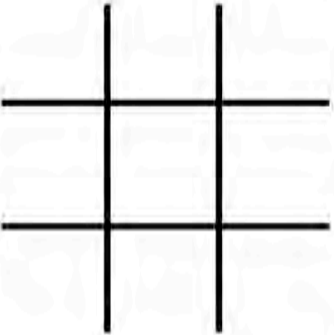
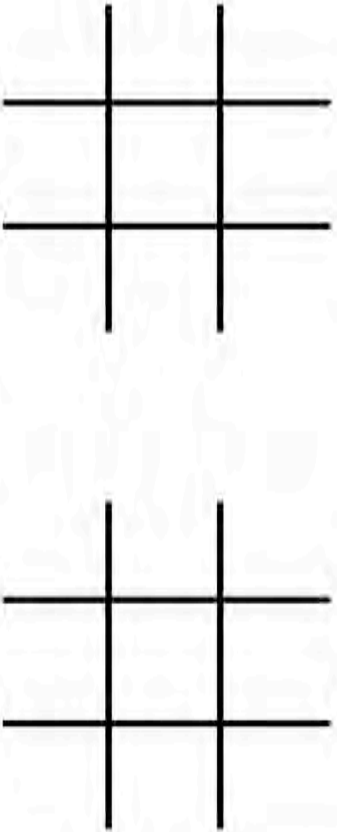
ACTIVITY # 1 : SCRIPTURE MATCH

Look up each of the Bible verses below and see if you can match it with the correct scripture. When you finish ask your small group leader to help you check your answers.

ACTIVITY # 2: MEMORY VERSE TIC TAC TOE

10. Play a 2nd round and finish filling in the squares by using the tic tac toe board in the other persons book.
